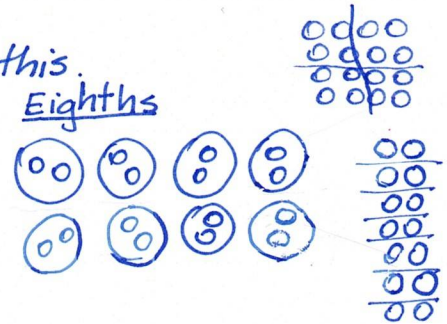
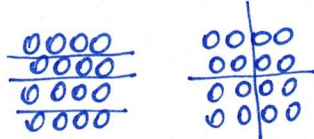

5. Share 16 counters to show quarters. Then show eighths.

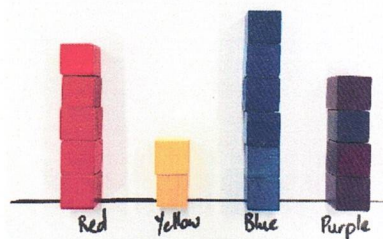
Any group or array that demonstrates this.



Measurement/Geometry:

This will vary. Allow your child to round it to half or quarter hours. You may need to talk about what time lunch will be happening
- Describe how to get from your bedroom to the kitchen. How many steps are needed? How do you have to turn?
Encourage your child to actually do this and describe the steps and turns as they happen. You can write it down for your child.
